# RIO DE JANEIRO AND IGUAZU

6 days / 5 nights

## DAY 1 Rio de Janeiro.

Arrival at the airport and transfer to the selected accommodation. Time at leisure. In the evening we suggest taking an optional: Rio by Night. Enjoy a spectacular samba show with singers and dancers in elaborate costumes who present Brazil's rich folkloric traditions and capture the famous rhythms of Carnaval. Duration: approximately 5 hours Dinner is included at Plataforma Steak House on private basis. Dinner is included at Carretão Ipanema on regular basis. Does not operate on Sundays.

## DAY 2 Rio de Janeiro.

Depart from the hotel after breakfast to visit the most famous landmarks of the city and see the natural beauty of Rio de Janeiro from up above. After a scenic drive along Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, passengers arrive at the bottom of the Corcovado Hill. Embark on a comfortable train that ascends the mountain, where the statue of Christ the Redeemer is located 2,300 ft. above sea level. The Christ statue, known as the "wonder of Rio", was recently elected one of the 7 "New Wonders of the World". Upon arrival at the top, guests can use the panoramic elevators or escalators to arrive at the foot of the statute. There, passengers can enjoy a panoramic view of Rio de Janeiro and discover why it is called the "Marvelous City". Afterwards, descend the mountain and stop for a delicious Brazilian Barbecue lunch. Over a million tourists each year visit the world famous 'Pão de Açúcar', (Sugar Loaf Mountain), which has become an iconic symbol of the city of Rio de Janeiro. Rising up from a small peninsula at the entrance of Guanabara Bay, its name is said to refer to its resemblance to the traditional shape of a concentrated, refined sugar loaf. The journey to the top is made in glass cable-cars. The first cable-car takes passengers to the top of Urca Hill, which rises 215 meters above sea level and offers spectacular views of the entire bay and its surrounding islands. From Urca Hill, passengers continue in a second cable-car to the top of Sugar Loaf which rises 395 meters above sea level and offers a 360 degree view of the entire city including Botafogo and Copacabana Beaches, Corcovado Mountain and downtown Rio de Janeiro. Duration: approximately 8 hours. Lunch will be served at Estrela do Sul BBQ.

## DAY 3 Rio de Janeiro.

Time at leisure. Take an optional excursion to explore Rio in a different way such as Cultural Rio or Discover Santa Teresa.

## DAY 4 Rio de Janeiro / Iguazu.

Transfer to the airport to board the scheduled flight to Iguazú.

Arrival and reception at the airport. Upon arrival transfer to the Foz do Iguazu National Park. Walking along the paths on the Brazil Side you will get startled by the panoramic view of the most imposing falls. Accommodation.

## DAY 5 Iguazu.

In the morning you will visit the Argentinean side of the Iguazú falls, located within the Iguazú national park, one of the first protected areas in South America, declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO and one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature We will take the train to Garganta Station where we will get off for a walk up to the Devil's Throat balcony, to share one of the greatest shows on Earth. The excursion continues along the upper and lower paths to get a close view of the imposing waterfalls. Take the Great adventure as an optional tour. A brief navigation to reach the San Martin waterfalls and a ride on 4WD truck for a fascinating jungle safari along the Macuco trail. Return to the hotel.

## DAY 6 Iguazu / Rio de Janeiro.

Day at leisure, then transfer to the airport to take the scheduled flight.
